### Course Descriptions for 2019-2020

**Hands-on Cultures:** Five to seven year olds will spend the year delving into cultures in the Western Hemisphere. First, where are we located? Then, where is France? Mexico? Italy? Who lives there? What do they eat? What do they wear? Through read-alouds and hands-on activities, the students will get a taste of life in faraway places. They’ll think about how geography and natural resources shape the way people live. They’ll create art, eat food, and play games common to each culture. They’ll gain a sense of their place in a world of diverse people that God loves...and have a lot of fun doing it!

**Hands-on History-- Ancient Cultures:** Seven to nine year olds will spend the year traveling back to ancient times. Art, architecture, technology, famous people, geography, and more: Ancient Egypt, China, Greece, and Rome are full of colorful characters and amazing accomplishments! Students will hear stories, create art, design and build, play games, and be absorbed into the ancient world with memorable, active learning experiences.

**World History-- The Age of Exploration through the Industrial Revolution:** Nine to eleven year olds will begin their year in the 1500s as the Old World met the New World. Through read-alouds, map work, and creative, memorable activities, they’ll study important people on every continent whose lives impacted this pivotal transition in world history. From Magellan to the Wright brothers, history will come alive for our Deerstream students!
