



## 2024-2025 Supply List

### Every student, every Deerstream session, should bring...

- **water bottle** marked with the student's name
- nut and sesame- free **snack and lunch** (if staying for Café and Play) in a plain lunch bag (mark all components with the student's name)
- plain **backpack** for carrying supplies and projects
- **layers** (sweater, coat) **labeled with student's name**
- **dress-code appropriate clothes** (see student handbook)

### ALL Elementary Classes: Science, Writing, and Social Studies (ages 5-11)

#### A labeled pencil box/bag, with all items labeled, containing:

- Sharpened pencils with good erasers

- Largest scissors appropriate for the child, labeled
- Pack of colored pencils
- 2 glue sticks
- Ages 9 and up: a black Sharpie

#### For Writing Class:

- A journal
- One folder

### Junior Division Prep English (Corpening) and Science (Harris)

#### A labeled pencil box/bag, to be brought back and forth to Deerstream, containing:

- Sharpened pencils with good erasers
- Handheld pencil sharpener with collection cover
- Scissors
- Pack of colored pencils
- Glue sticks
- Small bottle of hand sanitizer
- Black Sharpie
- 3 ring binder, 2 inches, with notebook paper and 4 subject dividers for each class
- English only: a composition book

### Junior Division and High School Classes

#### Junior Division English, Mrs. Williamson and Mrs. Embry, Mondays

- 1 one subject spiral notebook

- 3-ring binder- 1.5 or 2 inches, with notebook paper and 4 subject dividers with clear overlays in front/back
- 12-count pack of colored pencils
- Pencils or pens with dark blue or black ink

**High School English, Mrs. Ransom, Mondays**

- 3-ring binder, 2 inches, with notebook paper and 4 dividers
- Pencils, pens, eraser
- Colored pencils
- Pencil sharpener
- Printer, paper, backup ink cartridges at home
- Scissors and a glue stick

**World History, Mrs. Eriksen, Thursdays**

- 3 ring binder, 2 inches, with notebook paper and dividers
- Pencil or pen
- Small pack of colored pencils

**Junior Division Physical Science, Mrs. Hall and Mrs. Chyatte, Wednesdays and Thursdays**

- 3-ring binder, 2 inches, with notebook paper and 4 dividers
- Basic scientific calculator (TI-30XIIS is an example)

**High School Biology, Mrs. Briscoe, Wednesdays**

- 3 ring binder, 2 inches, with notebook paper and dividers
- Basic calculator
- Colored pencils
- Pens/pencils

**PreAlgebra, Dr. Johnson, Thursdays**

- 3 ring binder, 2 inches, with notebook paper and 3 dividers
- Calculator (TI-30XIIS or something equivalent is great. Please label your calculator)
- Ruler and scissors
- Sharpened pencils (no pens!)
- Eraser

**Algebra 1, Mrs. Embry, Thursdays**

- 3 ring binder, 2 inches, with clear overlays in front/back with notebook paper and 3 dividers
- Calculator
- Ruler
- Sharpened pencils (no pens!)
- Eraser (the eraser is VERY IMPORTANT =)

**Geometry, Mrs. Hall, Wed/Thurs**

- 3-ring binder, 2 inches, with notebook paper and 3 dividers
- Scientific calculator (TU-30XIIS is an example)
- Graph paper
- Sharpened pencils (no pens!)
- Eraser (the eraser is VERY IMPORTANT =)

**Items NOT to bring to Deerstream:**

- Cell phones
- Watches that receive messages
- Laptops or other electronics
- Toys from home
